

SAFE PLAY GUIDELINES

STC will follow Lackawanna County, CDC and USTA guidelines. The STC board has developed the following guidelines and requests your compliance:

- 1. Monitor your temperature daily. If you feel sick, stay home. Do not chance your own health or the health of our members.**
- 2. Please arrange play prior to arriving. If playing in a league, league coordinators will send out pairings and court assignments ahead of time. No loitering to arrange pick up matches.**
- 3. Stay in your car & text your group. When everyone playing has arrived, you may assemble on court. We recommend wearing a mask at the club, but it is up to your personal discretion whether you continue to wear one during play.**
- 4. The front gate will be locked. We ask you to walk around the fence to avoid creating a touch point. We will use the gate between courts # 5 and #2/3. Please wipe the latch with sanitizer after opening.**
- 5. Men will use double doors to enter restrooms and women will enter the single door. Sinks and commodes will be operational, showers will not. We ask that you wash hands before and after you visit the restroom. You are asked to wipe down with disinfectant all that you touch, this includes commode handles, doorknobs and sink handles. There will be receptacles for discarding of disinfecting wipes by doors.**
- 6. At the current time, no chairs will be on patio or courts. Please bring your own chairs to use on the court. We will allow changing sides, but we ask you move in a counterclockwise direction.**
- 7. We are asking all players to have a new can of balls and label with your initials. USTA recommends singles play but if you choose to play doubles, we ask for a set of balls for each side that is labeled with your identifying marks.**
- 8. Please bring personal sanitizer. We ask this as a courtesy to other members and to not rely completely on STC for sanitizing needs.**
- 9. The kitchen and water fountain will be turned off, so please bring your own beverage.**
- 10. This is a delicate ask, but use a tissue if you must expectorate, blow your nose, or wipe eyes and discard in your own bag. Sanitize your hands before play.**
